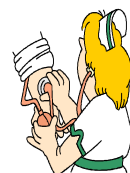

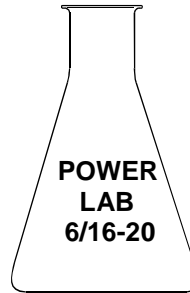
PREP – (Parish Religious Education Program) registration for the 2008-09 year is being taken. If you did not receive a letter and need to register a student or students for the coming year, please call Mary Ann, 301-777-3131, ext 8, and a form will be mailed to you.

REMINDER – For a child to be eligible for the reception of the Sacraments of Reconciliation, Communion and/or Confirmation, the child must attend PREP or BW for a year prior to the reception of the Sacrament. To receive the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Communion in 2nd Grade, the student must have received religious instruction in the 1st Grade. Likewise, to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation in the 9th Grade, the student must have received religious instruction in 8th Grade.

STAND – for the Protection of Children and Youth, re-screening process will begin in the fall. If you were certified through this Archdiocesan program in 2003, you will need to complete and sign a VolunteerSelect Criminal History Screening Consent form. Volunteers must renew their STAND certification every 5 years. If you volunteer time or would like to volunteer to work with children, please call Joy, 301-777-3131, ext 102 and a form will be sent to you. Please remember, unless you complete the STAND process, you may not volunteer to work with children and youth.

MARYLAND STATE SCHOLARSHIP – worth up to \$4,000 annually are available for current teachers and college students in exchange for teaching in the state’ Catholic schools in a field with a critical teacher shortage. The deadline to apply for the *Workforce Shortage Student Assistance Grants* for the 2008-09 academic year is Tuesday, July 1st. Undergraduate and graduate students who receive the award, which is renewable for up to five years, must become certified and agree to teach in Maryland’s Catholic, nonpublic or public schools. Subject areas with teacher shortages include special education, English for Speakers of Other Languages, and high school sciences.
